

Short Business summary

Ibis Institute is an institute for intercultural counselling and seminars in Germany. In the field of intercultural counselling we support Governmental Organizations (GO's) and Nongovernmental Organizations (NGO's) concerning integration processes. We work in projects with municipalities, social services and immigrant organizations (especially Turkish and Russian immigrant organizations). We support the work of these institutions with concept development, scientific research (e.g. concerning gender roles), assist in the practical implementation of intercultural projects (moderation, monitoring, scientific and practical input, evaluation) and help in the project handling (controlling, documentation). The question of intercultural and interreligious exchange of different cultures, is one important aspect of our work in the field of intercultural counselling.

In the field of intercultural seminars and lectures we offer inputs and workshops concerning intercultural dialogue and migration, different cultures and conflicts e.g. „What is Islam?“, „Muslims in Germany“, „Role of Women in Islam“, „Russian or Volga Germans“, „Dialogue with African people“, „Diversity in German Administrative Organizations“ etc. For us it is important that we work directly with citizens with and without migration backgrounds in the processes and seminars. Even though we give scientific inputs we want to do practical work that helps people directly and improve the cohabitation of different cultures and religions.
